I met Fred as a 19 year old who was compelled to leave college and join the historic struggle for justice for migrant farm workers. Fred converted me from a shy but committed participant to a confident organizer who in turn mobilized hundreds of people over many years.

I worked with the United Farm Workers for seven years, and happily, in my next job as an organizer with the national grassroots organization Neighbor to Neighbor I had the opportunity to continue work with Fred who into his 80's showed no signs of waning commitment and few signs of slowing down. Today I am the Co-President and Co-CEO of Equal Exchange, a \$50 million employee-owned cooperative that has engaged the coffee and chocolate industries in building social justice through "fair trade" in the marketplace. Even in this position I count on lessons learned from Fred Ross, Sr. over many years.
